ORDINANCE NO. 4 of 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO, LAWRENCE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING THE STORAGE AND PLACEMENT OF TRASH AND OTHER REFUSE CONTAINERS

Section 1. Collection and Storage of Trash Containers

- A. All trash customers are to place their trash and recyclables out for collection no later than 7:00 a.m. on the day of collection and no earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the day before collection. Any trash containers, recyclable containers and other refuse containers are to be removed from the curb no later than 7:00 p.m. on the day of collection.
- B. When placed out for collection, trash containers, recyclable containers and other refuse containers shall be placed at the curb of the property and in no case shall any items or containers be placed in a public street or in any manner which protrudes into a public street.
- C. On non-collection days, all trash containers, recyclable containers and other refuse containers shall be stored inside the building, residence or other structure, or shall be stored in a location behind the front facade line of the structure. Where a lot has more than one frontage on a public street, trash containers, recyclable containers and other refuse containers, on non-collection days, shall be stored either inside or placed behind the front facade line on all sides of the structure adjacent to any public street.

Section 2. Violation

- A. The following shall be a violation of this ordinance, subject to the penalties provided below:
 - Placing trash, recycling, refuse or other containers or items on a public street, or in a manner such that the items or containers protrude or spill onto a public street;
 - b. The failure to store trash, recyclable and other refuse containers on non-collection days in compliance with Section 1.

Section 3. Penalty for Violation

A. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before any District Justice, as a summary offense, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300, plus all court costs, including reasonable attorney's fees; and in default of payment, may be sentenced and committed to imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days. Every day that a violation of this ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following the said date of enactment.
