

Regular Monthly Meeting  
February 13, 2014

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, February 13, 2014, 7:00 PM at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with Supervisors Russell Riley, William Albertini and Albert Burick present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Superintendent Phillips gave the monthly police report.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to approve payment of the general fund expenses. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to approve payment of the sewer fund expenses. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to approve payment of the fire tax fund expenses. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to approve payment of the liquid fuel fund expenses. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to approve the transfer of the building and grounds of the South Hills Athletic Association to Shenango Township. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to authorize the Solicitor to proceed with the development of the Ordinance for the purpose of purchase/selling of the sanitary sewer system to the New Castle Sanitation Authority. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Burick to adopt Resolution #1 of 2014, as well as, previous years 2011, 2012 and 2013. All in favor, motion carried.

The Board of Supervisors wished to thank EMA Coordinator John Krueger for his efforts in helping to secure funding through FEMA and PEMA. Mr. Krueger stated that the township will receive approximately \$387,000, to be used for repairs from the July 10, 2013 storm and flood.
