

Regular Monthly Meeting
March 20, 2014

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, March 20, 2014, 6:00 PM, at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with Supervisors Russell Riley and Albert Burick present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Burick to approve payment of the general fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Burick to approve payment of the sewer fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Burick second by Mr. Riley to approve payment of the fire tax fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Burick second by Mr. Riley to approve payment of the liwuid fuel fund expenses. Motion carried.

Solicitor Perrotta noted that an executive session was held earlier in the week to discuss personnel matters.

Motion by Mr. Burick second by Mr. Riley to authorize the solicitor to proceed with the development of Ordinance #2 of 2014, which will serve as the execution and delivery of the Transfer Agreement and sale of the Shenango Township Sanitary Sewer System to the New Castle Sanitation Authority. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Burick to approve the Robert E. and harry E. Crisci Subdivision, contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department. Motion carried.

Public Comment:

Mrs.Rebecca Dando, Albourn Avenue, stated that there is a sanitary sewer issue on her property. Mr. Riley stated that the supervisors are now aware of the problem and have been in contact with

the township engineers and are in the process of resolving the issue, which may include various residents tapping into the public line.

Mr. David Wagner, Old Butler Road, asked if any new development with the storm water issue on Old Butler Road. Solicitor Perrotta stated that correspondence with Attorney Seltzer including easements and right of ways are still in the process.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Burick to adjourn. Motion carried.
