Robert Burnside of 3828 Stewart Avenue contacted Tony Sbarra. Solicitor Lou Perrotta said to correct the problem, the property owners would first have to consent to a dye test. John Krueger, Public Works Department, said he will check the road.

Mr. Bill Alexander complained about high grass at WKST. Superintendent Phillips said they are looking to put a "Stop Sign Ahead" below the corner of Gardner Center and Old Pittsburgh Roads.

Ms. Roberta Filer, 2406 Savannah Road, asked about hiring a zoning officer.

A question was asked about flooding on Hamilton Street by the 50' x 30' building. It was said that it would be looked into.
