RESOLUTION NO. 5 OF 2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO, AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE U.S. COMMUNITIES INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Section 1902 of Act 57 of May 15, 1998, (Title 62 PA C.S. 1902) known as the "Commonwealth Procurement Code" states that a public procurement unit may either participate in, sponsor, or conduct or administer a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of any supplies, services or construction with one or more public procurement units or external procurement activities in accordance with an agreement entered into between the participants; and

WHEREAS, a local procurement unit is any political subdivision, public authority, educational, health, or other institution; and to the extent provided by law, any other entity, including a council of governments or an area government; nonprofit fire, rescue or ambulance company; and any nonprofit cooperation operating a charitable hospital; and


WHEREAS, an external procurement activity is a buying organization not located in this Commonwealth which if located in this Commonwealth would qualify as a public procurement unit. An agency of the United States is an external procurement activity; and


WHEREAS, the U.S. Communities Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement is an external procurement activity; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby deemed to be in the best interest of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors to participate in the U.S. Communities Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors that Shenango Township will participate in the U.S. Communities Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement in accordance with an agreement entered into between the participants.
