The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, May 9, 2013, 7:00 PM, at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with Supervisors Larry Herman, William Albertini and Russell Riley present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Albertini to approve payment of the general fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Albertini to approve payment of the sewer fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Albertini to approve payment of the fire tax fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Albertini to approve payment of the liquid fuel fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Riley second by Mr. Albertini to adopt Zoning classification of Parcel ID no. 31-246100, from an R-2 Residential District classification to a C-2 Highway Commercial District to coordinate with lot lines. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the PD Acquisition Land Development Plan contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department. Building construction on Commerce Avenue Lot #2. Motion carried.

Motion to approve Maintenance Agreement with PennDOT on the by-pass lighting, replacement of bulbs and supplying electricity.

Mr. Herman explained that the recent strike that effected the trash collection was not Allied Waste but a strike at the land fill which the drivers would not cross.
