Regular Monthly Meeting May 12, 2011

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

Superintendent Phillips gave the monthly statistical police report.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Albertini to adopt Resolution #3 of 2011, to establish interest rates on outstanding municipal claims which would be pursuant to recent case law.

Public Comment:

Mr. Art Hairhoger, Old Princeton Road, asked when his bank would be repaired, Mr. Herman stated that he could possibly bring in large limestone pieces to correct the problem.

Mr. Joe Monsour, asked if anything could be done about the unordained portion of Motor Street, storm water from Old Butler Road and Motor are causing a water problem on his property. Mr. Albertini stated that he would try to install some drain pipes in the area to try and correct the problem.

Mr. Doak, Bryn Mar, asked with the recent change in the law could something be done about the house on Bryn Mar. Mr. Herman stated that the law has changed but that no new funding was made available. Superintendent Phillips stated that he could look into it criminally.

Mr. Doak, also stated that the edge of Gardner Stop Road is kicking out stones when he cuts his grass. Mr. Albertini stated that he would place some millings in the area to try and correct the problem.
