

Regular Monthly Meeting  
November 14, 2013

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, November 14, 2013, 7:00 pm at the Shenango Township Municipal Building, with Supervisors Larry Herman, William Albertini and Russell Riley present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

The police report was given by Superintendent Phillips.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Riley to approve payment of the general fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Riley to approve payment of the sewer fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Riley to approve payment of the fire tax fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Riley to approve payment of the liquid fuel fund expenses. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Albertini second by Mr. Riley to approve the Mario Subdivision replat contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department. Motion carried.

Motion to adopt Resolution #4 of 2013, Lawrence County Hazard Mitigation Plan, in order to be eligible to receive FEMA and PEMA funding. Motion carried.

Motion to adopt Resolution #5 of 2013, entering into an agreement for financial assistance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency for public disaster assistance.

Motion by Mr. Herman second by Mr. Albertini to authorize the Solicitor to proceed with the exploration and research of the possible selling to the sanitary sewer lines and lift stations. Motion carried.

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Public Comment:

Mr. Dave Wagner, Old Butler Road, asked the status of the storm water problem. Solicitor Perrotta stated that the property owner was contacted and informed that corrective action is needed. The process will with the possibility of establishing right of ways, storm water management, estimated costs for correction, as well as, easements and emanate domain.
