ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1977

The Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordania as follows:

- SECTION 1: Title: This Ordinance shall be known as the Cass Street No Parking Ordinance.
- SECTION 2: Definition and Interpretation: Words and phrases, when used in this Ordinance, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, as now in force or as hereafter amended. The singular shall include the plural and the masculing shall include the feminine.
- SECTION 3: Parking Prohibited on Cass Street: Parking shall at all times be prohibited on Cass Street in Stenango Township
- SECTION 4: Penalties: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Jollars, nor

more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 5: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective five days after the date of its enactment.
