AMENDMENT TO SHENANGO ORDINANCE NO. 1967-4

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, have determined that certain amendments to the Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1967-4 are needed, and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, have fixed Thursday, July 10, 1975 at 7:00 p.m., D.S.T., at the Shenango Township Municipal Building, 900 Allegheny Avenue, Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, as the time and place for a public hearing on the proposed amendment to the Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1967-4, and

WHEREAS, legal notice of the time and place for said public hearing and setting forth the proposed amendment was given in the New Castle News on June 24, 1975; being not more than sixty /**, days nor less than seven (7) days in advance of said public hearing, and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held on Thursday,
July 10, 1975 at 7:00, p.m., D.S.T. at the Shenango Township
Municipal Building, 900 Allegheny Avenue, Shenango Township,
Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, and a full opportunity to be heard
was given to all citizens or parties in interest seeking to be
heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania:

that Section 5 of the Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1967-4 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Where such sewage is directed or caused to flow into an individual or community sewage disposal system, a permit shall be procured at the time of the installation of the same and a fee in such amount and sum as the Board of Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania may determine and set by resolution from time to time shall be paid to the Township at the time of making the application for the construction of the same."

This amendment to the Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1967-4 shall become effective five (5) days after its passage or adoption.
