WHEREAS, legal notice of the time and place for said public hearing and setting forth the proposed amendment was given in the New Castle News on June , 1977; being not more than sixty days nor less than seven days in advance of said public hearing, and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held on Thursday, July 14, 1977 at 7 o'clock p.m. D.S.T. at the Shenango Township Municipal Building, 900 Allegheny Avenue, Shenango Township, Lawrence County Pennsylvania, and a full opportunity to be heard was given to all citizens and parties in interest seeking to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania:

that Section 1 of the Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1967be and is hereby amended to read so that the minimum charge per mont for a 5/8 inch or less meter be charged from the present \$3.80 to \$4.50 so that that portion of Section 1 shall read:

5/8 inch or less, or per dwelling unit when two or more dwelling units are services through one meter.
