

AMENDMENT TO SHENANGO TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 9-1986

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WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, have received the engineering report completed from the NBIS inspection of the bridge located on Route T-471, more commonly known as the Old Butler Road; and

WHEREAS, said engineering report recommends that the posted weight limit be reduced from 15 tons to 10 tons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

That the bridge located on Route T-471 more commonly known as the Old Butler Road, in Shenango Township, shall be posted with a weight limit of 10 tons.

This amendment to the Shenango Township Ordinance No. 9-1986 shall become effective five (5) days after its passage or adoption.

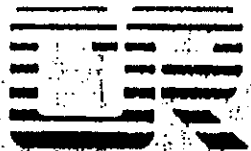

As you are aware, we recently completed the NBIS inspection for the above referenced bridge. The concrete deterioration is continuing thereby affecting the integrity of the structure. Although no eminent danger exists, we believe a reduced posting to 10 tons will lengthen the life of the bridge until such time as a replacement is constructed.

As was also explained, the concrete abutment backwall is in immediate need of repair. We feel that this repair should take place as soon as better weather conditions occur.
