

## \*\*Attention Shenango Township Resident\*\*

The National Weather Service in Pittsburgh has issued a Flood Watch that effects Shenango Township in Lawrence County, Pennsylvania.

At 8:41 AM EST Friday, February 23, 2018

## \*\*Heavy rainfall is expected through the weekend\*\*

Many locations had received in excess of two inches of rainfall last weekend. The ground has had little time to recover from this amount of rain, and many locations are already saturated. Some locations received between one and two inches of rain yesterday and another two to three inches of rainfall is possible through Sunday afternoon, flooding will be a possibility across the forecast area.

The ground is very saturated and water levels in local streams remain high.

The City of New Castle is currently monitoring water levels at the body of water located in Cunningham Park off Cascade Boulevard.

Road closures should be expected in the local area.

A Flood Watch means there is a potential for flooding based on current forecasts.

You should monitor later forecasts and be alert for possible Flood Warnings. Those living in areas prone to flooding should be prepared to take action should flooding develop.
