

Regular Monthly Meeting
February 16, 2007

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Friday, February 16, 2007, 4:00 P.M. at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with Supervisors Larry Herman and Bob Peters present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Mr. Herman read the Police Report.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Herman to approve payment of the general fund expenses.

Motion by Mr. Herman second by Mr. Peters to approve payment of the sewer fund expenses.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Herman to approve the St. Vitus Cemetery Subdivision, contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department.

Motion by Mr. Herman second by Mr. Peters to approve the Shenango School District Subdivision, contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Herman to approve the James & Phyllis Hooks Subdivision, contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Herman to authorize the Solicitor to advertise for a Township Parking Ordinance.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Herman to authorize the Solicitor to prepare a proposal regarding a Jake Brake Ordinance.

Public Comment:

Mr. Manny Weinschenk, Pennsylvania Avenue, asked what the Parking Ordinance was for. Mr. Herman stated that it would now enable the Township Police Department to issue tickets for parking violations throughout the township.

Mr. Bill Watkins, Gardner Center Road, asked why the meeting was moved to Friday, Mr. Herman stated that this was due to a lack of quorum. Mr. Watkins also wanted to discuss an incident at the Lawrence Village Plaza involving the Police Department and

the deployment of the Taser device. Solicitor Cilli, advised Mr. Watkins that due to the nature of the case and it possible litigation that the matter would no be discussed at the meeting.

Mr. Bill Alexander, Savannah Gardner Road, expressed his dissatisfaction with the use of anti-skid and salt in certain areas throughout the township. Mr. Alexander also suggested that the Police assist with traffic when the school buses are departing the school in the afternoon.

Mr. Sam Garver, Dean Drive, stated that the culverts at the end of Dean Drive both will need replaced, he believes due to the bus traffic.

Mr. Garver also asked why more Township employees do not attend the meetings.
