

Regular Monthly Meeting
October 12, 2006

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, October 12, 2006, 7:00 pm at the Shenango Township Municipal Building, with Supervisors Larry Herman, Bob Peters and William Albertini present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

The Police Report was given by Officer Lough.

Public Comment:

Mr. Tim Buck, 1002 Service Street, asked if Carol Reed would be moving her office back into the Township Building. The Supervisors stated that they will be discussing this with the School administration.

Mr. Ken Cannon, Forrest Avenue, requested that the ditch line be cleaned on the lower part of Forrest Avenue.

Mr. Dale Wehr, Willowbrook Road, asked who is the contractor for the street lights? Mr. Herman stated that the Street Lights were Penn Power, By Pass lights St. John Electric and Traffic Signals Bruce & Merrilees. He also asked the status of the street light at the bottom of Willowbrook Road, Mr. Herman stated that the pole and base had to be manufactured it is on order and that it should be installed in the near future. Mr. Wehr also asked the status of the proposed skate park and who would cover the insurance? Mr. Herman stated that the skate park is in the planning stages and that ultimately the township would have to provide some type of insurance.

Mr. Oran Allen, Savannah Gardner Road, asked who is the head of the park advisory board, Mr. Peters stated that Mrs. Snyder stated she would be interested.

Mr. Sam Garver, Dean Drive, asked if the sign post could be painted or have a reflectors added to it at the end of Dean Drive. Mr. Garver also asked for more traffic control for speeding on Route 65 and in the school zones and if the State Police could run radar in the Township.

Mr. Oran Allen, Savannah Gardner Road, asked how the mowing is planned. Mr. Herman stated that the first time through a single pass is made and then on the second trip he will mow back as far as possible.
