

Regular Monthly Meeting
July 13, 2006

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, July 13, 2006, 7:00 pm at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with Supervisors Larry Herman, Bob Peters and William Albertini present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Officer Dave Lough gave the Police Report.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Albertini to approve payment of the general fund expenses.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Albertini to approve payment of the sewer fund expenses.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Albertini to approve the ESB Bank subdivision contingent upon satisfaction of reviewed items by the Lawrence County Planning Department, environmental review and DEP approval.

Motion by Mr. Peters second by Mr. Albertini to approve PAWC to place a fire hydrant at the end of the ordained portion of Cornell Avenue.

Public Comment:

Mr. Dave Dowdell, Aiken Road, asked how the recycling bins are working out. Mr. Peters stated that so far all has been going well. Mr. Dowdell also commended the Police Department.

Ms. Rose Mary Henderson, asked if the township provides an office for Rob Ratkovich, Mr. Peters stated that Mr. Ratkovich does housing inspection and is not provided an office he has a filing cabinet and works from the meeting room.

Mr. Jim Bintrim asked is a stop sign could be placed at the on ramp from the by pass onto 422 East.

Ms. Cindy Pringle, asked if 3 properties on Moravia Street need to be removed or cleaned up. Mr. Peters stated that one is slated to come down and the others are being looked into as possible health hazards.

Mr. Oran Allen, Savannah Gardner Road, commended Dave Strohecker for mowing along the township roads. Mr. Allen also would like the traffic signals looked into at the intersection of Savannah and Old Princeton Road.

Mr. Peters stated that PennDot will once again be contacted with the request.

Mr. Many Weinschenk, Pennsylvania Avenue, would like to know if the township can return the Turnback roads. Mr. Peters stated that he had been told no but would contact PennDot.

Mr. Dale Wehr, asked if the street light at the bottom of Willowbrook Road was going to be repaired, Mr. Herman stated that the insurance has paid for the light and we are waiting on PennDot approval. Mr. Wehr also state that the 2nd light in the parking lot is in need of repair, it was damaged during the renovation.

Mrs. Dottie Angelucci, Nearwood Drive, asked if the bridge would still be replaced on Old Butler. Mr. Herman stated that it would be going out to bid in September.
