

Regular Monthly Meeting
September 19, 2006

The Shenango Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, September 19, 2006 at the Shenango Township Municipal Building, with Supervisors Larry Herman and Bob Peters present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Chief Nocera gave the Police Report.

Motion by Mr. Herman second by Mr. Peters to appoint Maurice Waltz as an alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer.

Mr. Paul Young, Reno Lane, asked if the township would do anything to stop spotting along Reno Lane. Mr. Peters stated that he would contact the Game Commission to see what could be done.
