Road Construction Projects

Shenango Township, Pennsylvania – The Shenango Township Board of Supervisors would like to alert residents and motorists of improvement projects within the Shenango Township limits. As a result of the ongoing Castlewood sewage and water infrastructure project, many township roads are currently in disrepair. Beginning Monday, April 9, 2018, Youngblood Paving will begin trench repair, resurfacing and berm restoration on Pennsylvania Avenue, Savannah-Gardner Road and a short portion of Savannah Road. Delays should be expected. More roads will be added to the restoration timeline as the infrastructure project moves forward.

Beginning Monday, April 9, 2018, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation will begin preparations for the backfilling of the Route 65 railroad bridge at Cascade Park. This \$ 898,758 project has been awarded to Independence Excavating, Inc. Delays should be expected in this corridor of the township and complete Route 65 road closures should occur this summer, with a posted detour.

Starting Tuesday, April 10, 2018, the Shenango Township Public Works Department will be commencing spot paving operations on portions of Old Pittsburgh Road between Union Valley Road and Shenango Park Drive. Road closures and delays should be expected.

Continuing delays are expected on the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Savannah Road project through the final surface application.

Motorists are reminded to allow extra time when traveling on the above roads. Please obey all posted traffic signs for the safety of those working on the roads.
