

Regular Monthly Meeting
January 4, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday, January 4, 2010, 4:00 pm at the Shenango Township municipal building with Supervisors Larry Herman, Bob Peters and William Albertini present.

Mr. Herman called the meeting to order; the minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

The police report was read.

Mr. Herman, stated that in the year ahead several issues will be looked into, such as, rezoning for business districts, try to keep taxes down, Act 537 is now in the review process with DEP with an estimated cost of 12 to 14 million dollars to extend sewer lines. Working with PAWC, to extend water lines. The development of the plaza, including a hardware store which should open in late March, with a grocery store to follow. Marketing the property along route 65. Working with Michelle Nestor to establish one carrier for trash and recycling in the township. Negotiating with Cemex to close Sandbank Road.

Mr. William Alexander, Savannah Gardner Road, stated that he hopes that the new police superintendent Bill Phillips does a good job.
