

## Regular Monthly Meeting

January 7, 2008

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors on Monday, January 7, 2008, 4:00 p.m. at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with Supervisors Larry Herman, Bob Peters, and William Albertini present.

The meeting was opened.

### Public Comment:

Mr. Dale Wehr, 1007 Willowbrook Road, asked that the recycling bins be removed and asked the Supervisors for a motion for the removal of the bins.

Mr. Scott Stoner, 1001 Willowbrook Road, asked that bins be removed or to be placed elsewhere behind a fence and a locked gate. Due to the trash and dust that it creates.
