WHEREAS, the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards, which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 200) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Shenango acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and ,

WHEREAS, The Lawrence County 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Lawrence County Planning Department and the Lawrence County Department of Public Safety in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of Shenango Township and,

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Lawrence County 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Lawrence County 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan, recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; by the governing body of Shenango Township, the Lawrence County 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Township and the respective agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Lawrence County 2010 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
