

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a majority of the property owners along a 20 foot alley running between Motor Street and Service Street in Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, have petitioned the Township of Shenango to vacate said 20 foot alley, and

WHEREAS, said alley was laid out by the Public Service Land Company in a plan of lots which was recorded on March 3, 1930 in the Recorder's Office of Lawrence County, Pennsylvania in Plot Book Volume 8 page 35, and

WHEREAS, said 20 foot alley has never been taken over by the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania and made a part of its public road system, and

WHEREAS, it is questionable that said alley would ever be needed as a part of the public highway system of the Township of Shenango.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS,

1. That the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania hereby relinquishes and releases any and all right, title, interest and claim that it has in and to that portion of a 20 foot alley running from the Westerly line of Service Street to the Easterly line of Motor Street in the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania and being bounded on the North by Lots numbered 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 and bounded on the South by Lots numbered 41 and 26 in the plan of lots laid out by the Public Service Land Company, a copy of said plan being recorded in the Recorder's Office of Lawrence County, Pennsylvania in Plot Book Volume 8 page 35.

Henry Wettich, Chief Assessor, to henceforth pick up all properties situate in Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, that would come under the Interim Assessment Law.

RESOLUTION

John Tanner, that the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, due to the crowded facilities of the present municipal building and the need for enlarged quarters, the Township Supervisors are considering the erection and construction of a new Township Municipal Building, and

WHEREAS, the County of Lawrence owns land situate in Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, located along the New Castle-Ellwood City Road and adjacent to the property owned by the Lawrence County Society for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc., and

WHEREAS, said lands owned by the County of Lawrence would provide a convenient and adequate area for the construction and erection of a new Township Municipal Building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of Shenango Township, on behalf of said Township, purchase from the County of Lawrence, Pennsylvania, a parcel of land approximately 300 feet by 600 feet as located along the New Castle-Ellwood City Road and being adjacent to the Lawrence County Society for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc. as the Supervisors deem it to be for the best interest of the Township to purchase said lands for the erection and construction of a Township Municipal Building and other Township uses.
