REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held Thursday, April 14, 1988 at 7:00 p.m. with supervisors Joseph Shinsky, Andrew Piccuta and Ronald Golba present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the March 10, 1988 meeting.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to pay general fund bills totaling \$40,994.34. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to pay sewer fund bills totaling \$3,142.71. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to grant requests for Per Capita Tax refunds. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to pass resolutions which exonerate the Tax Claim Bureau from collecting taxes on certain properties within the township. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to designate April as Housing Awareness Month. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to award contracts to the following road material bidders: Limestone & Anti-Skid Material - Smith Paving; Emulsion - Russell Standard; ID-2 Hot Mix Surface/Base, Cold Patch, & #9 Hot Mix Topping - Gennaro Pavers Inc.; Premium Lead Free Gasoline & Diesel Fuel - Guttman Oil. Motion carried.

Police Chief Anthony DeCarbo gave the police report & also noted that all training for the Vascar Unit has been completed and police department will begin to use the unit on April 16, 1988.

The floor was then opened for complaints or suggestions from the citizens in attendance, the following was discussed:

1. Citizen complained about the nuisance of Motor Bikes. Police Chief Anthony DeCarbo explained that he would have the area of Hamilton Street Extension and Pennsylvania Avenue patrolled more often to try to control the problem.

2. Citizen complained about the high speed of drivers using Pennsylvania Avenue. Police Chief Anthony Decarbo answered that the Vascar Unit will be enforced on April 16, 1988 and all areas will be tested for high speed drivers.
