Regular Monthly Meeting April 14, 2005

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the previous meeting.

Chief Nocera gave the Police Report.

Motion by Mrs. Wehr second by Mr. Albertini to approve Ordinance #3 of 2005, repealing Ordinance No. 1-1997, and any other Ordinances that set sanitary sewer charges.

Public Comment:

Mr. Ken Cannon, would like to see more police patrols in the Rt 65 area, speeding and passing in the area between the traffic signals, between the hours of 4 and 5 PM and in the early morning.

Mr. Don Tedrow, asked if there would be a spring clean up, it was suggested that it could occur in August or September, due to the road construction. Mr. Tedrow also stated that Lawrence County Roads possibly the worst in the state.

Mr. Jim Bintrim, commented on the daily activity report. The current report used is not sufficient. Mr. Bintrim stated that the Supervisors should control the work, machinery and equipment and the Road master is to inspect the roads.

Ms. Brenda Yakubik, stated that she would like to have turning arrows on the 388 & 422 intersection on all four sides. She has tried to submit a letter to PennDot to change the light timing pattern.

Mr. Jeff Seadom, stated a sink hole by the catch basin on Dean Drive and the upper section catch basin is too high and needs filled.

Mr. Ken Cannon, asked do part-time employees receive benefits, and who sets the salaries and vacation for part-time employees and roadmaster.

Mr. Sam Garver, stated that various junk items are coming down stream, possibly from the cemetery.
