MONTHLY MEETING

The monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held Thursday, July 14, 1988 at 7:00 p.m. with supervisors Joseph Shinsky, Andrew Piccuta and Ronald Golba present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag.

The minutes were read and approved from the June 9, 1988 meeting.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to pay general fund bills totaling \$14,765.25. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to pay sewer fund bills totaling \$ 4,372.85. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to grant real estate refunds. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to pay wage tax refunds. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Joseph Shinsky to adopt Resolution for consulting fees for Adams, Graney and Associates. The fees will paid for any consulting the firm performs for the FFY 1988 Block Grant Application. The actual application is being completed by the Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to adopt Resolution 24-1988. This resolution represents the application to Penn Dot for a permit for a traffic signal to be installed at the Lawrence Village Plaza. Motion carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Ronald Golba to award the bid for the traffic light revision at the intersection of the Ellwood Road and Princeton Road to Traffic Control and Engineering Co from West miffilin, Pennsylvania. Motion carried.

The floor was opened to the residents in attendance for any questions that they might have. The following was discussed:

Mr. Fontanesi of 1317 Old Princeton Road asked the supervisors if they had approved the completion of the Old Princeton Road. The supervisors informed Mr. Fontanesi that neither the sewer lines nor the road have been turned over to the Township for acceptance in that area.
