## Regular Monthly Meeting March 29, 2001

Motion by Sherry Wehr second by Rick Flora to approve the Daniel Strickler Subdivision, contingent upon satisfaction of review items by the Lawrence County Department of Environmental Services.

Motion by Sherry Wehr second by Rick Flora to appoint William Klingensmith, as the alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer.

Motion by Sherry Wehr second by Rick Flora to Ratify an easement along Daughtery Road to install water line in the right-of-way, pursuant to the recommendations by the solicitor.

Supervisor Wehr, commended, Paul Lynn for the EMS plan, as well as, Nick Ventura and Larry Herman, the State will be using the plan as a model for other communities.

## Public Comment:

Mr Oran Allen: asked if any thing had been heard in regard to the status of the plaza. If the timing for the traffic signals could be staggered and retimed to give ample time for traffic pulling out from Savannah Road. Mr. Allen also asked the residency requirement for employees.

Mr. Larry Bintrim, asked who is monitoring the installation of sewer lines on Aiken Road, and if the Township is participating in the 911, address project.

Mr. William Alexander, stated material needed to be broomed from the intersections, litter being cleaned up along the road way, and speeding on Old Pittsburgh Road and Rt 65.

Mr. Sam Garver, asked the status of the by -pass lights, and commented on the trash behind the plaza and the shopping carts in the creek.
