

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MAY 11, 1995

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, May 11, 1995, 7:00 pm at the Shenango Township Municipal Building with supervisors Richard Schweinsberg, Joseph Budai and Andrew Piccuta present.

The meeting was opened with a salute to the flag, followed by a moment of silence for Mr. Edward Gallagher, former municipal authority member who passed away earlier in the week.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to appoint Brian D. Tanner as Secretary/Treasurer - Community Development Director. Motion Carried.

The minutes were read and approved from the April 13, 1995 meeting.

Police Chief Anthony DeCarbo gave the police report.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to pay the general fund bills. Motion Carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Joseph Budai to pay the sewer fund bills. Motion Carried.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to pay the tax refunds. Motion Carried.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to adopt Resolution 3-1995; to make an application to the Lawrence County Commissioners for an allocation of county Liquid Fuels Tax Funds in the amount of \$35,625.82. Motion Carried.

Motion by Andrew Piccuta second by Joseph Budai for contract 95-1; PennVest Storm Water Project to Honey Creek Contracting. Motion Carried.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta for contract 95-2; Roof Construction Salt Storage Facility to Firedex of Butler. Motion Carried.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to grant C&W Consulting a Fifty-nine cent raise retroactive to January 1, 1995. Motion Carried.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to award bid on equipment to Russell Standard. Motion Carried.

Motion by Joseph Budai second by Andrew Piccuta to approve the Thomas W. DiFrischia subdivision contingent upon satisfaction of review items given by the Lawrence County Planning Commission. Motion Carried.

Motion by Richard Schweinsberg second by Joseph Budai that any certified letters sent by the sewage enforcement officer along with any judication law enforcement be reimbursed by the township. Motion Carried.

Public Comment:

Mr. Michael Buly: Questioned the reputability of Honey Creek. Supervisor Schweinsberg stated inquiries were made and samples were examined and found to be satisfactory and that a performance bond must be furnished.

Mr. Larry Bintrim: Questioned the Board if he could have the Road Masters time sheets. Mr. Budai responded that this board will not give any further time sheets or other materials out and will now only do so by order of the Ethics Commission. Supervisor Budai also stated that Mr. Bintrim contact the ethics commission if he wishes to do so. Mr. Bintrim also questioned why the Storm water Project could not have been bid on a separate area basis. Supervisor Schweinsberg stated that the bid was held as per the direction and regulations set forth by DER and that the township was instructed not to have separate area bids.

Mr. Gene Pavia: Thanked the Board for installing a light for the flag.
