The following citizens comments were heard:

(1) It was questioned as to why Brattz Road has not yet been opened. He was informed that the Road Crew has been busy on several projects and that it would be taken care of.

- (2) It was recommended to the Board to write a letter to the turnpike commission concerning the fee being charged to use the new portion of Route 60.
- (3) The Currie and Houk Subdivisions were brought forward asking why the Board would not approve them. They were informed that because the lots have not been perk tested, they could not be approved. They were tabled until the next regular meeting.
- (4) Mr. Irwin of Hoover Road asked for the Board's decision as to the distance from the water line a home could be in order not to tap into the line.
