

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS,

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO ARE CHARGED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY OF PROTECTING THE SAFETY, HEALTH, AND WELFARE OF ITS CITIZENS, AND

WHEREAS,

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HAVE CREATED A MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP WHERE FOUND NECESSARY AND FEASIBLE, AND

WHEREAS,

THE MOST FEASIBLE METHOD FOR THE TREATMENT OF SEWERAGE APPEARS TO BE THROUGH A CONNECTION WITH THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT, AND

WHEREAS,

IT IS NECESSARY TO TRANSPORT SAID SEWAGE FROM THE TOWNSHIP TO THE TREATMENT PLANT THROUGH CITY-OWNED SEWER LINES, AND

WHEREAS,

THESE LINES ARE KNOWN TO PRESENTLY BE OF INADEQUATE SIZE AND WILL NOT ACCOMMODATE THE ADDITIONAL SEWERAGE TO BE GENERATED IN THE TOWNSHIP, AND

WHEREAS,

THE IMPROVEMENT OF THESE LINES, MORE ESPECIALLY THAT LINE KNOWN AS THE BIG RUN INTERCEPTOR, IS NECESSARY TO PERMIT THE TOWNSHIP TO CARRY OUT ITS SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO DO HEREBY REQUEST THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE TO UNDERTAKE THE IMMEDIATE APPOINTMENT OF AN ENGINEER TO MAKE THE NECESSARY SURVEYS, TO DETERMINE THE COST OF

IMPROVEMENT TO THAT SEWER LINE KNOWN AS THE BIG RUN
INTERCEPTOR, AND PRESENT TO THE BOARD SAID FINDINGS WITH
COUNCIL'S PROPOSAL FOR THE SHARING OF THE COST OF SUCH
IMPROVEMENTS AND ENGINEERING SURVEYS AS ARE FOUND TO BE
NECESSARY.
