# TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO LAWRENCE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO, LAWRENCE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING THE SHENANGO TOWNSHIP DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, INC.

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

#### **SECTION 1. Title**

This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Shenango Township Development Corporation Ordinance" (hereinafter referred to as "Ordinance").

#### **SECTION 2. Authority**

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Second Class Township Code.

#### **SECTION 3. Intent**

The Township is desirous of creating and participating in a community development corporation for the purposes set forth in the articles of incorporation of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. and in doing so has approved by Resolution 12 of 2017, the filing of certain articles of incorporation of the same. *A copy of the Resolution is attached as Exhibit 1*.

#### **SECTION 4. Purpose**

The purposes of this Ordinance to provide for the appointment of those members of the Board of Directors of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. who are to be appointed by Shenango Township as provided by the articles of incorporation and/or the bylaws of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. and to provide enabling authority for the conduct of affairs of the corporation.

#### **SECTION 5. Incorporating Municipality**

The incorporation of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. was accomplished by the filing of the corporations' Articles Non-Profit with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of State-Corporation Bureau. *A copy of the Articles are attached as Exhibit 2*.

#### SECTION 6. Board of Directors

- (A) The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of a Board of Directors. The powers of the Corporation shall be exercised by, or under the authority of the Board of Directors except as otherwise provided by statute, the Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws, or a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors.
- (B) The Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) Directors. The Directors shall be appointed by the Board at the annual meeting of the Board. Each Director shall serve for an initial term of one (1) year. The first Board of Directors shall be appointed by the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors to serve from date of appointment to the date of the first annual meeting.
- (C) At the conclusion of their initial one (1) year term, members of the Board of Directors may serve additional three (3) year terms. Their terms shall be staggered so that at the time of each annual meeting, the terms of approximately one-third (1/3) of all members of the Board of Directors shall expire.
- (D) Members of the Board of Directors shall not receive any compensation for their services as Directors.
- (E) Whenever any vacancy occurs in the Board of Directors it shall be filled without undue delay by a majority vote of the remaining members of the Board of Directors at a regular meeting. Vacancies may be created and filled according to specific methods approved by the Board of Directors.

#### **SECTION 7. Officers**

The officers of the Board of Directors shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer. All officers must have the status of active members of the Board.

#### **SECTION 8. Powers and Duties**

- (A) The powers and duties of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. and its officers are to:
  - 1. Assist in alleviating and preventing conditions of unemployment.
  - 2. Assist in retaining and attracting local industries and commercial enterprises;
  - 3. Assist industrial and commercial enterprises in locating, purchasing, constructing, reconstructing, modernizing, improving, maintaining, repairing, furnishing, equipping, and expanding in Shenango Township.
  - 4. Construct, acquire by gift or purchase, reconstruct, improve, maintain, modernize, repair, furnish, equip and expand projects, and acquire the necessary lands for the site therefore;
  - 5. Acquire by gift or purchase the necessary machinery, furnishings, and equipment for a project;
  - Borrow money and issue revenue bonds or revenue notes to finance all or part of the costs of a project, including machinery, furnishings and equipment and the necessity sites therefore;
  - 7. Enter into, execute and carry out leases, lease purchase agreements, installment sales contracts with any person, firm or corporation for the use or sale of the project;
  - 8. Lease, mortgage, sell, and convey the project or any part thereof for a price and at a time as the corporation determines;
  - 9. Lend, grant, transfer, or convey funds as permitted by law;
  - 10. Assist in alleviating blighted and deteriorating properties and neighborhoods;
  - 11. In general to do and have such powers not prohibited by law and to this extent all powers provided by law upon corporations created and incorporated pursuant to the Non-Profit Corporation Law of 1988, as amended, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- (B) Such powers are hereby incorporated in this section as powers of the corporation and its officers, in addition to all other powers conferred thereupon by law. It shall be the power and the duty of the officers of the corporation to implement, carry out, and execute the powers and duties described in this section of the corporation.

## **SECTION 9. Body Corporate**

The Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. shall be a body corporate with power to sue and be sued in any court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It shall possess all the powers necessary to carry out the purpose of its incorporation and those incidental thereto. The enumeration of any powers in the Corporation's Article of

Incorporation shall not be construed as a limitation upon such general powers of the Corporation.

# **SECTION 10. Terms of Corporate Existence**

The term of existence of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc. is perpetual or until dissolved in accordance with the Non-Profit Corporation Law of 1988, as amended, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

# SECTION 11. Bylaws and Regulation of Internal Affairs

- (A) The Board of Directors, by an affirmative vote of a majority of its members shall adopt bylaws for the operation of affairs of the Shenango Township Development Corporation, Inc.
- (B) The regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including the distribution of assets or dissolution or final liquidation, is placed entirely with the Board of Directors or their successors, as provided in the bylaws of this corporation, subject, however, to the provisions of the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1988, as amended, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

#### **SECTION 12. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its approval as provided by law.


