ORDINANCE NO. 2 of 2019

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE SHENANGO TOWNSHIP PER CAPITA TAX ORDINANCE, NO. 1 OF 1960, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania (the Township) is a Second Class Township, governed by the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 65101, et seq., which authorizes the Board of Supervisors to adopt ordinances to exercise the general and specific powers of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. § 66601) permits repeal of an existing ordinance by the enactment of a subsequent ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Township desires to repeal the Per Capita Tax Ordinance, No. 1 of 1960, as amended by the Per Capita Tax Amendment Ordinance, No. 1 of 2005; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention to adopt this Ordinance has been published on November 29, 2019, and December 5, 2019, in compliance with the notice provisions of the Local Tax Enabling Act and the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this repeal was held by the Board of Supervisors on December 12, 2019;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1. Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1 of 1960, along with Shenango Township Ordinance No. 1 of 2005, are hereby repealed in their entirety.
- 2. If any Section or part thereof or any part of this Ordinance should be held invalid for any reason, such determination shall not affect the remaining sections or parts of this Ordinance, and to that end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
- 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon being duly adopted.
