ORDINANCE NO. 3 of 2019

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE SHENANGO TOWNSHIP LIGHT TAX

WHEREAS, Shenango Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania (the Township) is a Second Class Township, governed by the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 65101, et seq., which authorizes the Board of Supervisors to adopt ordinances to exercise the general and specific powers of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to repeal the Light Tax, enacted pursuant to 53 P.S. § 68205(a)(2); and

WHEREAS, notice of intention to adopt this Ordinance has been published on November 29, 2019, and December 5, 2019 in compliance with the notice provisions of the Second Class Township Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the repeal was held by the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors on December 12, 2019;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Shenango Township, Lawrence County Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. The Light Tax imposed pursuant to 53 P.S. § 68205(a)(2) is hereby repealed.
2. Any Township Resolution or Ordinance imposing such a light tax is hereby repealed in its entirety.
3. If any Section or part thereof or any part of this Ordinance should be held invalid for any reason, such determination shall not affect the remaining sections or parts of this Ordinance, and to that end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.
4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon being duly adopted.
