GREETINGS FROM YOUR SHENANGO COMMUNITY PARK

2020 was a very exciting year at the Shenango Community Park, as the Park grew from a 15-acre park to a 35-acre park with the purchase of an additional 20-acre parcel which also connects the park to Old Pittsburgh Road. This will give the Township the ability to continue to grow the park into the future.

2020 saw the start and completion of several projects at the park, including the wooded grove area, the new parking area off Old Pittsburgh Road. The addition of the children's book along the paved walking trail allows children to read a story as they walk the trail.

SHENANGO COMMUNITY PARK RECEIVES DCNR GRANT FOR MASTER SITE PLAN DEVELOPMENT



In 2020 Shenango Township was awarded a \$20,000 grant from the state Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to develop a Master Site Plan for the newly acquired property adjacent to the current park. In 2020 parks took on a new role as so many events and activities were canceled or closed. Parks became a place that residents have been able to escape to and relax with family and neighbors. The Shenango Township Board of

Supervisors intends to begin the Master Site Plan project in 2021 with involvement by the Shenango Community Park Board serving as the steering committee.

WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT PICKLEBALL, AMERICA'S FASTEST GROWING SPORT ?

Did you know that Shenango Community Park is home to one the area's largest pickleball groups. Pickleball is a paddle sport which combines the elements of tennis, badminton and ping-pong. You most certainly can find a game of pickleball any time of the day in the summer at Shenango Park, and Shenango Park courts are periodically the site of regional pickleball tournaments as well.

PARK SHELTER RENTALS

Are you looking for a wonderful and affordable way to host your next outdoor celebration?

The Shenango Township Community Park offers shelter rentals, all of which are developed with access to playground equipment and restroom facilities. Residents and nonresidents have the opportunity to rent the Park Shelters shown below.



Rentals for 2022 begin on Tuesday, February 1, 2022

Park shelter rental costs include use of electric (where available) and shelter rental. Please remember that these are public parks and open space will remain open to the public. If a user would like to use inflatable, they must be approved by the Township prior to use (no water inflatables allowed; for a full list of prohibited items, please visit shenangotownship.org). The renter MUST supply a Certificate of Insurance (COI) by Operating Vendor with a \$1,000,000.00 policy; naming Shenango Township as additional insured with 1000 Willowbrook Road, New Castle, PA 16101 as the address and include a copy of the vendor's permit to conduct business. Once the COI and Business Permit is received, only then will the renter be allowed to have the inflatable on park property. This MUST be supplied prior to your event. These documents may be mailed to the Township address above or faxed to 724-658-1255 with ATTN: Park Rentals.

- Hours of Operation: Dusk-Dawn
- Shenango Community Park is ADA
