

Regular Monthly Meeting
October 13, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, October 13, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. at the Shenango Township Municipal Building, with Supervisors Albert Burick, III, Brandon Rishel, and Frank Augustine present. Lou Perrotta was also present.

The meeting was called to order and opened with a salute to the flag.

Mr. Augustine announced that prior to the meeting the Board of Supervisors had an executive session for personnel and legal.

Motion by Mr. Rishel second by Mr. Burick to approve the minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting of September 8, 2022. Motion carried.

Staff Reports/Announcements:

EMA Coordinator/Zoning Officer Justin Data gave the monthly Fire Department report and reminded everyone October is Fire Safety Month. There are a small amount of smoke detectors and batteries available for pick up at the municipal building. Mr. Data was able to secure the grant for these items for the 3rd year in a row.

Mr. Burick reminded everyone that Trick or Treat for Shenango Township will be held on Monday, October 31, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Burick announced that we will be having our annual Shenango Township Tree Lighting Extravaganza being held on Friday, November 18, 2022, from 5:30 p.m.-8:00 p.m.

Mr. Burick announced leaf pickup will begin in the township on November 1st. All leaves must be in biodegradable bags, and residents should call the Municipal Building to have their leaves picked up.

Public Comment:

Mick Malizia of Forest Ave wanted to thank Lou and the supervisors for all their help over the years.

Dan Gallagher brought up the need for blinking lights on the Hollow Road stop signs intersecting with Harmony Baptist Road. Mr. Rishel is going to look more into what we can do for that intersection but fears that the blinking lights will be stolen soon after they are placed.

Motion by Mr. Rishel second by Mr. Burick to approve Resolution #25 of 2022- DCNR Grant-Shenango Township Park Improvements. Motion carried.
