RESOLUTION NO. 12 OF 2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHENANGO, LAWRENCE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ENTERING INTO A INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION SOUTH NEW CASTLE BOROUGH COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the Township of Shenango, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania recognize the mutual benefits and efficiencies that can be achieved through collaboration and shared resources in the provision of municipal administration services with the South New Castle Borough Council, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS the Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, specifically 53 Pa. C.S. § 2305, provides that any such joint cooperation agreement between two or more governmental entities may be approved by ordinance or resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Shenango Township Board of Supervisors and The South New Castle Borough Council hereby enter into an inter-governmental agreement for the shared provision of municipal administration services, under the following terms and conditions:

1. Purpose & Scope

This agreement aims to provide the delivery of municipal administration services, including but not limited to:

- a. Public meeting preparation,
- b. Prepares and pays bills,
- c. Preparation of annual budget,
- d. Record retention,
- e. Other mutually agreed-upon administration activities.

2. Duration of the Agreement

This agreement shall commence on the ratification of this agreement and shall remain in effect for a period of 2 years unless terminated earlier by mutual consent of the parties.

3. Financial Arrangements

South New Castle Borough shall pay Shenango Township for services received at a rate of \$41.60 per hour, of the service provided by the Township.

4. Governance Structure


The Shenango Township Administration Department shall remain at all times under the sole discretion of Shenango Township. In addition, the Administration Department performing services associated with this Agreement will at all times

remain and be considered an agent of the Township and they will not be considered an employee of the Borough.

5. Amendment & termination


Eiter party may terminate this agreement, for any reason, with or without cause, by providing thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.
