Bids will be awarded at the Board of Supervisors Meeting, April 11, 2024 which begins at 6:00 p.m. or subsequent meeting as determined to be in the best interest of Shenango Township.

**Specifications for
Furnishing Road Materials**

1.01 General:

Proposal for the furnishing of Road Materials for Shenago Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania.

Sealed proposals will be received by the Township Secretary until 10:00 a.m., April 11, 2024, at the Township Office, 1000 Willowbrook Road, New Castle, Pennsylvania 16101, with a bid opening session immediately following at 10:15 a.m., April 11, 2024, at the Shenago Township Municipal Complex, 1000 Willowbrook Road, New Castle, Pennsylvania 16101.

1.02 Preparation of Proposal:

Proposal must be submitted on the form provided in these contract documents, and it must not be removed from the documents.

Proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside the name of the bidder and his/her address, and it shall be clearly marked:

"SPRING/SUMMER ROAD MATERIALS"

If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the proposal and marked as designated above, must be enclosed in another envelope addressed as indicated in Paragraph 1.01.

1.03 Awarding:

The award may be made at the meeting of the Board of Supervisors on April 11, 2024 (6:00 p.m.), or a subsequent meeting so designated by the Board. The Township reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals and to waive technicalities as may be deemed in the Township's best interest.

Low bid for any and all materials will be determined using a modified Life Cycle Cost Method along with standard engineering economic methods. The Township reserves the right to split the road materials bids. (See page 4)

1.04 Interpretation:

If any person contemplating submitting a bid for the proposed contract is in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of these proposed contract documents, he/she may submit to the Township Manager a written request for an interpretation up until one week prior to bid opening.

1.05 Tax Exemption:

The Township of Shenango is exempt from Federal and Pennsylvania State Tax. Exemption certificates will be furnished to the successful bidder.

1.06 Exceptions:

All exceptions to the specifications must be clearly noted or bidders shall be required to meet specifications.

1.07 Contract:

The term of this contract shall be one year, beginning on the day of the award of the bid by the Board of Supervisors and terminating one year later.

1.08 Fuel Adjustment:

If requested by the bidder or the Township, there will be consideration for quarterly bid price adjustments if fuel costs change appreciably. Accurate fuel records must be kept for fuel adjustment consideration.

1.09 Non-Collusion:

All Bidders are required to complete a Non-Collusion Affidavit. This affidavit may be required on all projects involving public funding as provided in Section 7 of the Pennsylvania Anti-Bid-Rigging Act. The Non-Collusion Affidavit must be submitted with the bid.

1.10 Quantities:

The quantities provided in the bidding documents are only Township estimates for upcoming 2024 projects, the bidders should be prepared for the Township to order any quantity up to the advertised amount in the 2024 construction season.
